



Student Termination Policy,

At Vedanta School of Nursing and Paramedical Science, we are dedicated to fostering an environment that upholds academic excellence, ethical conduct, and a commitment to the well-being of our student community. The termination policy outlined herein is designed to maintain the sanctity of our academic institution and protect the interests of both the students and the broader community.

Termination Criteria:

- 1) We adhere to a stringent set of criteria for student termination, which may include, but are not limited to, the following circumstances:
 - i. **Academic Performance:** Persistent failure to meet academic standards and requirements may lead to termination, as outlined in the academic policies of the institution.
 - ii. **Non-Compliance with Financial Obligations:** Failure to submit fees within the stipulated timeframe, despite reminders and communication from the administration, may result in termination.
 - iii. **Violent Behaviour:** Any act of violence or threat of harm towards fellow students, faculty, or staff members will be grounds for immediate termination.
 - iv. **Adulterous Activities:** Engaging in activities that violate the ethical standards and principles of the institution, including adultery, may lead to disciplinary actions, including termination.
 - v. **Ragging:** Vedanta School of Nursing and Paramedical Science maintains a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging. Any involvement in ragging, whether as a perpetrator or bystander, will result in immediate termination and legal action as per regulations.
 - vi. **Breach of Code of Conduct:** Violation of the institution's code of conduct, including but not limited to, dishonesty, plagiarism, and disruptive behaviour, may lead to termination.
 - vii. **Clinical Duty Non-Compliance:** Regular and consistent participation in clinical duties is a fundamental aspect of the education provided at Vedanta School of Nursing and Paramedical Science. Failure to regularly attempt clinical duty, frequent unexplained absences, and a demonstrated pattern of carelessness in fulfilling these responsibilities may be considered a serious violation of the academic requirements, leading to termination as outlined in the institution's policies.



2) Due Process:

We are committed to upholding principles of natural justice, ensuring a fair and transparent termination process. Students facing termination will be provided with an opportunity to present their case before a Termination Review Committee. The committee will consist of relevant faculty members, administrators, and a student representative. The decision of the committee will be communicated to the student promptly.

3) Appeal Process:

Students have the right to appeal the decision of the Termination Review Committee within a stipulated timeframe. The appeal will be heard by an impartial Ombudsperson, who will review the case and make recommendations.


4) Consequences of Non-Compliance:

Any violation of the termination policy will result in strict disciplinary action, as outlined in accordance with the regulations of Vedanta School of Nursing and Paramedical Science. This policy is enacted to maintain the integrity of our academic community and foster an environment conducive to learning, growth, and mutual respect.

5) Reserved Authority:

In specific circumstances, the school authorities reserve the right to terminate any student without prior notice, exercising the discretion to take stern disciplinary action at any time. Such actions are non-negotiable and not subject to questioning, emphasizing the commitment to maintaining a safe and conducive learning environment at Vedanta School of Nursing and Paramedical Science.
